Colonoscopy is an examination of the entire large intestine with a flexible instrument that is inserted through the anus. The condition for the examination to be successful and for the necessary procedures to be performed is that the intestine is well cleaned. The examination can be painful because the intestine must be inflated with air so that the entire intestinal mucosa can be viewed. In the case of pathological changes in the mucosa, a piece of tissue is pinched off during the examination if necessary. This is then examined under a microscope and the nature of the pathological changes is thus identified. We often encounter polyps in the intestine, which are usually benign formations, but which can turn into malignant or cancerous tumors over the years. Therefore, they are removed with a loop during the examination (polypectomy) and then pulled out of the intestine and examined under a microscope. Removal of a polyp is painless. We always try to remove all polyps at once. If the polyp is extremely large or in an inconvenient location and the risk of endoscopic removal would be too high, it is removed surgically.

Complications with colonoscopy and polypectomy are rare. There may be heavy bleeding after removal of the polyp or perforation of the intestinal wall. Only exceptionally may heart and respiratory disorders occur.

If you are taking blood-thinning medications (**Marevan, Xarelto, Eliquis, Brilique, heparins, etc.**), please consult your personal physician or a doctor at the anticoagulant clinic regarding the prior discontinuation of anticoagulant therapy.

Therefore, we ask that you inform us before the examination about any tendency to bleed, taking blood-thinning medications (Marevan, Xarelto, Eliquis, Brilique, heparins, etc.), hypersensitivity to medications and food, and about the diseases you suffer from, especially cardiovascular diseases, lung diseases, and chronic infections.

In a personal interview before the examination, we will answer your additional questions and clarify any ambiguities.

I declare that I am aware of the planned examination and possible complications and with my signature I give my consent for the examination and any additional procedures.

Special warning:

I also give my consent that the doctor may use sedation during the examination if he/she deems it necessary. Sedation may be performed with my prior verbal consent. The use of sedation is payable according to the applicable price list.
